Time Commitments:

Tutors commit to 1 hour per week and are matched with one student for the entirety of the classroom phase.

TAs commit to 2 hours per week and also help out in the #study-hall channel in Slack.

Industry Mentors commit to 2 hours per month, meeting virtually or in-person.

Mock Interviewers must have technical experience and can opt-in to lead one-hour interview sessions as they are comfortable.

Roles:

Tutor

Tutors work individually with students who would benefit from individualized support with the curriculum.

TA (Teaching Assistant)

TAs host drop in office hours open to any students who would like help with projects or reviewing concepts.

Industry Mentors

Mentors meet with students to give insight into tech culture, social support, networking tips and more.

Mock Interviewers

Help students and interns practice their interview skills by simulating a technical whiteboard interview in a low-stakes setting.
